What is the cost of the course?

The cost of the two-weekend course is a total of \$225.00. A \$75.00 deposit will hold one of the 48 participant slots. You may pay in total or in increments with all moneys received by June 1st, 2010. Financial Assistance is available.

What should I bring?

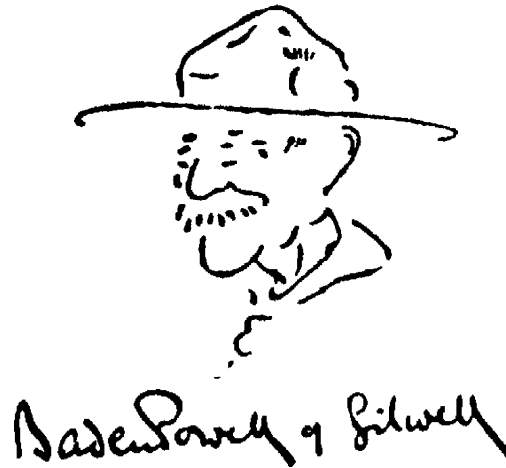
When your deposit has been received, a letter of welcome will be sent with all additional pertinent information, e.g., supply list, health record/physical, and personal survey.
